Call the Hilton NASA directly at 281-333-9300, or 1-800-634-4320. Please identify yourself as being with TX-SHHH. The hotel has a limited amount of assistive equipment kits for your rooms. Assistive equipment will be provided on a first-come, first-served basis. Please bring any assistive devices you may need in the event there are not enough to go around. The final registration date to guarantee rooms is October 15, 2002. The group room rates are \$89 a night plus tax for up to 4 persons in the room. The hotel features include an on-site restaurant with delicious meals, a waterfront swimming pool, hot tub, and Marina if you are interested in sailing to Clear Lake.

Travel Directions

By Car:

Take I-45 South to NASA Rd 1 (exit # 25) Go east on NASA Rd 1 for 5-6 miles. You'll pass Space Center Houston and NASA (fenced-in area) on the left. On the right is a tall, white building standing alone. That's it! You've arrived at the Hilton Hotel. (www.hilton.com)

By Airline:

Hobby Airport in Houston is approximately 15 miles from the Hilton. The approximate taxi rate is \$25.00. The Clear Lake Shuttle operates every 4 hours, departing Hobby at 8:00 A.M., noon, and 4:00 P.M.. (For pick-up after 4:00, advance reservations are required by calling @ 281-333-3873.) One-way fare is \$15.00 -- group rates are available if arranged in advance. Pick-up for the Clear Lake Shuttle Bus is outside of the baggage claim, curb zone # 6.

Bush Intercontinental Airport, located north of Houston, is 55-60 miles from the Clear Lake Area. If you fly into Bush, to avoid a taxi fare of \$64+, it would be best to fly on Continental as they fly a shuttle between Bush and Ellington Field, which is a few miles from the Hilton
